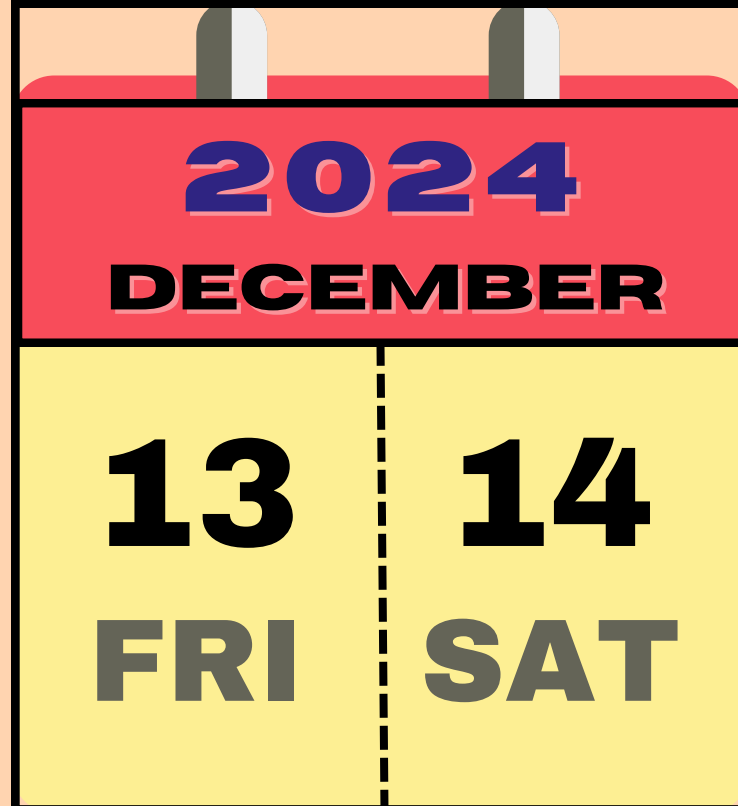

About Conference

Schemes and programmes are a part of the systematic plan of action to achieve a specific goal enshrined in the broader objective of public policy. The Union Government and Governments at sub-national levels announce different schemes, programmes and plans to achieve the proclaimed policy of the government. There have been a plethora of schemes announced by the Union and State Governments during the last two decades. A systematic approach for evaluation, content analysis, monitoring and post-project interventions are inevitable for a public policy to produce desired outcome. Against the setting, it is important to critically explore the nature of public policies in India *vis-à-vis* other countries in the world with special reference to the global south. Policies do not stand in isolation and draw similarities and resemblance to its closer or distant variants implemented in other countries. Policies in advanced and less developed countries are connected to one another as such policies are formulated and practiced by learning from the experience and consequential impacts of policies in other countries. A closer perusal of policies and programmes implemented in India calls for a global outlook and introspection.

The aim of the Two-Day National Conference is to critically reconnect the public policies across the countries, unearth the content, distributive impacts on different sections of the society. The conference papers will consider public policy in the context of India and other countries, especially for the Global South. The papers will explore public policy in terms of its determinants and outcomes, i.e., a) how public policies are impacted by the social nature of state as a complex of many institutions, including the government; international (financial) institutions, governments of advanced nations, private sector, people's community participation and societal pressure for public goods and services, and b) the extent to which and how public policy improves the economic, social and environmental conditions in the society.
