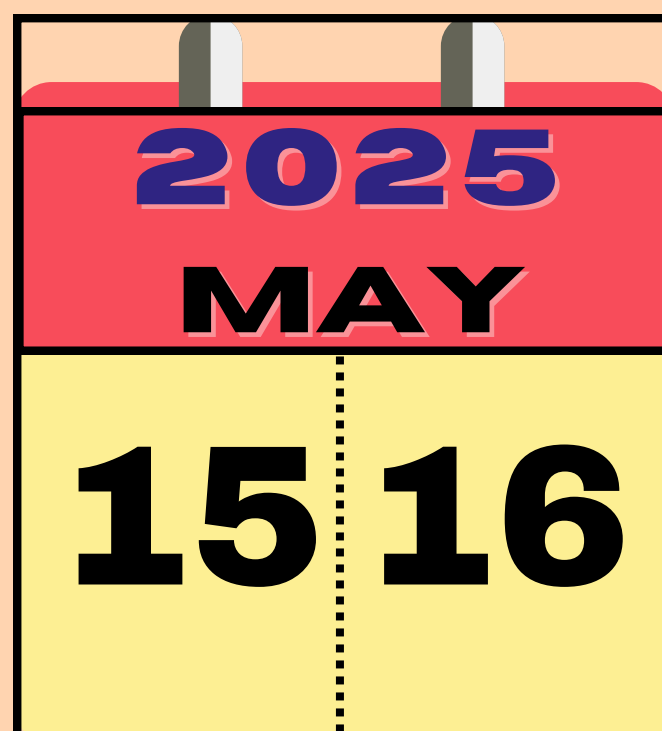

About Conference

Government schemes and programmes are a part of the plan of action to achieve specific goals. The Union Government and Governments at sub-national levels announce various schemes, programmes and plans to achieve their short-term and long-term goals. A systematic approach to evaluation, content, outcome analysis, and post-project interventions are essential to produce the desired outcome. Against the setting, a critical analysis of public policies in India *vis-à-vis* with special reference to the global south assumes special significance. The experience of advanced capitalist economies provides valuable insights to negative and positive externalities of development projects and schemes. Public policies in the global south draw similarities to schemes and programmes implemented in the global north. In this context, a close perusal of policies and programmes implemented in India calls for a detailed introspection.

The two-day national conference aims at reviewing the public policies across countries, for the distributive impacts on different sections of the society. The conference is expected to contribute to public policy in the context of India and the Global South. Research papers of the conference will explore public policy in terms of its determinants and outcomes, i.e., a) How public policies reflect the nature, content and priorities of the state as a complex unit of several institutions; b) What are the ways in which public policies reform economic, social and political ecosystem of the society at large.
